



## Hosting an interactive **Client Weatherization Workshop** in your community

### **DIY Home Weatherization Workshops and Energy Education Program**

CEP has been successfully providing client education for 30 years. Each year, CEP conducts up to 80 free weatherization workshops to over 800 Portland homeowners and renters. Workshops are lead by both CEP Staff and Volunteer Workshop Leaders. Participants receive information on simple, practical ways to lower home energy use and learn how to install low-cost, effective weatherization materials in their homes. We are able to bring this service to your area, or your organization can participate in our energy educator training program.



### **Client Follow-up Survey Results**

We've provided 25 years of physical site verifications and follow-up visits to 15-20% our clients annually. Complete reports are available upon request. Some highlights:

- On average, clients spend about 5 hrs weatherizing their own homes (after attending a 2hr workshop)
- Over the past five years, clients reported saving an average of \$30/month in the winter (70-80% reporting saving on bills).
- The usage rates for the most popular kit items are: reusable window kits (92%), CFL (92%), and door weatherstripping (80%).
- In a longer-term follow up survey (1-2 yrs after attending a workshop) 76% of people surveyed reused the window kits and 82% reported reusing something from the kit (including the window kits)
  - ⇒ 98% Reported that they remembered the workshop, and 92% said they learned something new at the workshop
