In-Home Services



We can install conservation supplies and make repairs for qualified seniors and people with disabilities in Portland. All labor and supplies are free.

Weatherization

Staff and trained volunteers install energy-saving materials for your home: window kits, efficient lights, door weather-stripping, etc.

Small Safety Repairs

We provide small safety repair services such as: installing grab bars, carbon monoxide and smoke detectors, and making minor carpentry repairs to small areas of stairs and porches.

Large Safety Repairs

Larger safety-related repairs such as roof leaks, electrical issues, minor plumbing, and more extensive carpentry.

Volunteers

We provide training and orientation for hundreds of volunteers each year for a variety of projects.

Weatherize homes, coordinate other volunteers, teach community workshops, canvass, provide administrative support, or donate professional services.
